

If your Alpine has the MCD roll up shades and you are having problems here are a couple of good videos from MCD on how to take apart the shades, the internal components, etc..

I've also snipped a shot from the video and circled the auto stop plastic wheel in black.. on the edge of the wheel are 3 raised dimples. These are the ONLY thing that holds the position of your roll up shade...

I've drawn 3 red lines and if you use a small pencil soldering iron, or a small finishing nail heated up touch the edge of the wheel in 3 spaces just long enough to make a slight indentation..



This will create raised edges around the indentation thus creating new stops for the auto stop wheel... it's as good as a new one
